


*Dimensions:118 x 166 cm)*




***Portrait of Picasso's mother (1896)***


## THE "BLUE" PERIOD (1901-1904)

- *the works created by Pablo Picasso between 1901 and 1904 are attributed to the "blue" period, since in the paintings of this period Picasso's accents of blue predominated. But this is far from the only feature*

*the girl on the ball (1905)*






