





Henri Matisse was born on December 31, 1869





as a young man, matisse
studied for a law degree
in paris.
at the beginning of the
20th century his art
reached a critical turning
point.



His use of watercolor in painting from nature and his meeting with famous artists allowed him to free himself from the traditional use of color, leading to the invention of Fauvism.

Painting in the style Fauvism, Matisse continued to emphasize the emotional power of sinuous lines, strong brushwork and acid-bright colors.




In the first decade of the century, Matisse also made sculptures and drawings that were sometimes related to his paintings, always repeating and simplifying his forms to their essence.
